T. MUMMY WRAP:

Materials:

- Rolls of toilet paper

Instructions:

- Divide the kids into pairs.
- One child in each pair becomes the mummy, while the other is the "wrapper."

Instructions:

- Have the kids take turns rolling the ball or small pumpkin towards the pins, attempting to knock down as many as possible.
- Each player gets two chances per turn, and the player with the highest score wins.

3. Halloyeen Scavenger Hunt:


Materials:

- List of Halloween-themed items to find (e.g., plastic spider, witch's hat, black cat figurine) – included within this PDF

Instructions:

- Use the list of Halloween-themed items for the kids to find.
- Hide these items around the party area or in your home.
- Provide the list to each child and let them search for the items within a specified time limit.
- The child who finds the most items within the time frame wins the scavenger hunt.











Materials:

- Small pumpkins
- Craft supplies (e.g., markers, stickers, googly eyes, pipe cleaners, paint)

Instructions:

- Provide each child with a small pumpkin and a variety of craft supplies.
- Let their creativity run wild as they decorate their pumpkins using the provided materials.
- Once everyone finishes decorating, have a contest where everyone votes for their favourite pumpkin.
- The pumpkin with the most votes wins the decorating contest.



5. Musical Monsters:

Materials:

- Halloween-themed music (can be downloaded or streamed)

Instructions:

- Arrange chairs in a circle, one fewer than the number of kids playing the game.
- Have the kids walk around the chairs while the music plays.
- When the music stops, each child must find a chair to sit on.
- Remove one chair after each round, and the child left without a chair is out.
- Continue playing until there's one child remaining, who becomes the winner.
